ABOUT THE SHOW: The show is being hosted by WCS Foundation and run according to the official rules of the American Shetland Pony Club (ASPC). This first show of the Tour is the kickoff to many more shows next year. They all will be pay back shows. First thru Third place will receive awards and pay back. Each of the Champions/Stake/Champion of Champion/Supreme Champion/Best of Show will all receive pay back and awards. Next year the Tour will have several shows for many to win. That is why we are doing the kickoff this year to give everyone a taste of what it will be like and so everyone will look forward to next year shows. We do have a lot of the dates and locations set but are going to have to look at how they correspond with other next year show dates. There will be Ladies Night on Friday, Men's Night on Saturday and then Family Day will be Saturday. We are hoping to make this a big enough show so that we can make it a four-day event with evening activities next year. Neither the Show, WCS Foundation, Double SS Show Management, the Michiana Event Center nor anyone working with the show will be held responsible for any accidents that may occur to persons, animals, or property. The exhibitors shall hold aforementioned persons harmless and indemnify them against any legal proceedings arising from such accidents.

AWARDS AND PRIZES:

There will be awards given to 1st thru 6th and Jr/Sr & Reserve Champions and Grand & Reserve Champions. Special awards will also be given to the Champion of Champion, Supreme Champions, and the Best of Show. Pay back for 1st thru 3rd place and for all Champions & Best of Show.

CHECK IN: The Show office will be open Thursday morning at 10 am until 8pm. Friday, Saturday, & Sunday opening at 7am and closing 1 hour after the completion of the show.

ENTERING YOUR HORSE: Send completed entry form(s) and copy of up-to-date Registration Certificates

for each animal. Please copy front and back, if needed, to verify current owner/lessee. Include copies of Youth and Amateur membership cards with your entry if applicable. Amateur and Youth applications will also be available from the Steward. Submit all fees due with your entry. **Please send in your entries by the deadline to be stalled in the main barn.**

ENTRY DEADLINES: Entries need to be postmarked or emailed by 9/15/20. Beginning on 9/16/2020 there will be a late fee of \$30 per horse added.

ENTRY FEES: Office fees are \$15.00 per back number. Open class fees are \$35.00 per class. Amateur & Non-Rated class fees are \$25.00 per class. Youth and COOL class fees are \$20.00 per class. Non Rated Classes (invitation only) are \$25. Stake class fees are \$50.00 per class. Late entry fees are \$30.00 per horse. Stall fees are \$70.00 per stall. **One horse per stall.** Shavings are \$10 per bag. If coming in early there is a \$30 per stall fee. Make checks payable to "Horsin' Around The States Tour". We also accept credit card payment (3% charge) and PayPal. Any returned checks will be assessed a \$50.00 fee. ENTRY POLICY: Entries accepted are considered final, refunds will not be given. If your horse is unable to compete due to illness or injury you may enter a substitute with no penalty upon presentation of documentation from your veterinarian stating the original entry is unable to compete due to illness or injury. Your stall and office fees will not be refunded. If you are unable to attend the show due to an emergency situation the Foundation will issue you credit to be used at a future Horsin' Around The States Tour show.

FACILITIES & CAMPING: The Michiana Event Center (MEC) is located at 455 E. Farver Street, Shipshewana, IN. Completely enclosed facilities with

wash racks (hot & cold water), restrooms, and lunch stand. Shipshewana RV Park is right next to the facility they have electricity, water, & sewer. They charge \$40 per night you will need to call them to make reservations 260-768-7627.

GENERAL RULES & REGULATIONS: This show is being run according to the official rules of the American Shetland Pony Club (ASPC). The Show, the ASPC / AMHR, the Michiana Event Center, nor anyone working with the show, will be held responsible for any loss or accidents that may occur to persons, animals, or property. The exhibitors shall hold aforementioned persons harmless and indemnify them against any legal proceedings arising from such accidents.

Deadline for class entering at the show will be 6:00 pm the evening before the class shows and performance classes must enter by 12:00 pm the day of the class.

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS: It is required that entries coming from out- of-state conform to health requirements for interstate transportation of horses from their state of residence to the state of Indiana. The Horsin' Around The States Tour along with Double SS Show Management reserves the right to ask for an on-site Vet inspection, at owner's expense, for any animal appearing to be in poor health.

MEASURING: Measuring will be beginning on Thursday, October 1st at 2:00 pm - 7:00 pm and Friday, Saturday & Sunday, October 2, 3, & 4 at 7:00 am and as needed and as Steward is available. Exhibitor packets and

numbers will be issued after measurement or presenting a 60-day measurement card. A clear copy of your registration papers must be presented at time of measuring.

NON-RATED CLASSES (NR):

Halter Champion of Champions to be judged from the Grand Champion Stallion, Mare & Gelding in each division with one winner placed.

Halter Supreme Champions to be judged from the Champion of Champion winners.

Performance Champion of Champions to be judges from the Stake Champion in each division.

Performance Supreme Champion to be judges from the Performance Champion of Champions winners.

BEST OF SHOW to be judged from the Halter Supreme and the Performance Supreme Champion winners.

STALLS AND SHAVINGS: Stalls for horses and/or tack are \$70.00 (Thursday arrival through the end of the show Sunday night). One horse per stall. Stalls must be ordered on entry form. All horses must be stalled, no jump-out allowed. **Early Arrival/Late Departure** (times before or after these require an additional \$30.00 fee per stall). Shavings will need to be ordered on your entry form at \$10/bag. Outside bedding is not allowed.

EXHIBITOR RESPONSIBILITY - TACK

CHANGES/GATE HOLDS: . It is the owner/handler/exhibitor's responsibility to be on time for classes. Announcements to the barn area are a management courtesy. As a courtesy to your fellow exhibitors, please report all Tack Changes/Gate Holds to the show staff at least 5 classes ahead of time. Every effort will be made to allow you the time you need. Once the class is given the final call the gate will be closed in two (2) minutes and no late exhibitors will be allowed into the ring. NO REFUNDS will be given for missed classes. All dogs MUST be on a leash while on the show grounds
